A MESSAGE FROM OUR CLUB CHAIRPERSONS

Dear Parishioner,

We are writing to you from Mooncoin GAA club representing the Senior club, the Camogie club and the Juvenile club. Firstly, we would like to take this opportunity to thank all parishioners for supporting our Lucky Draw fundraising initiative. Since the introduction of the draw in 2019, the funds raised have contributed to the annual running costs of the three clubs and enabled the club to commence further development of facilities for the future benefit of our players, members and the community in general.

Last year 2021 and continuing now into the early part of 2022 have been very exciting times in the history of Mooncoin GAA both on and off the field. Off the field, the completion of one of our biggest projects to date, the new club car park and entrance was a major milestone in the club's development culminating in the visit of the President of Cumann Lúthchleas Gael, Larry McCarthy to unveil the commemorative statue honouring the legacy of one of Mooncoin GAA Club's most decorated players, Richard 'Drug' Walsh in October. His statue not only becomes a focal point to the new entrance to our club grounds but also to the village of Mooncoin. A special word of thanks to our friends and members of the Mooncoin GAA Supporters Club of Australia who funded the entirety of this commemorative statue project.

The early part of the year also saw the completion of the club juvenile/warm-up pitch. This has been a fantastic asset for all in our club but in particular for our younger boys and girls. The installation of new signage around our pitches and car parks has just recently been completed. The club walk way remains ever popular with all

members of our community. The installation of lights in our new car park and protective lower netting to our main pitch goals has ensured the continued safety of all our patrons. The installation of a natural grass and flower area with the help of local landscaper Tommy Kieilty is a welcome sight when using our walkway. More recently, in case of medical emergencies, the club has purchased and will shortly install a second new AED device outside our complex building.

Despite the challenges of the continuing pandemic all three clubs have been very successful on the field of play. Unique in the club's history, on a weekend in November 2021 both the Junior Adult and Junior Camogie teams secured County titles. While a few weeks previously our Junior A team secured the County title meaning the club will field both Intermediate (Hurling and Camogie) and Junior (Hurling) teams in 2022. Success has continued into 2022 with a second Junior Leinster title within five years followed by an historic All-Ireland Junior Club win in Croke Park on Saturday 5th February. At juvenile level, the Camogie club were crowned U14 county champions while in August our U15 boys hurling team had success in the county Féile na nGael competition.

In 2022, the club have appointed their own Games Promotion Officer (GPO) who will provide over a two year period regular structured coaching to all primary school children in the parish and also work with our coaches to continually develop their coaching skills.

None of the developments listed here or indeed the development of our players and coaches would have been possible without your support of the Lucky Draw.

As you can imagine keeping the club facilities in pristine condition and the running of same, costs a lot of money. Annually, the running of the three clubs collectively totals approximately €120,000. For just €3.84 per week, you can enter the club Lucky Draw and have a chance to win one of 10 monthly prizes ranging from €500 to €50. You are also included in a Christmas Hamper draw. For this year's Lucky Draw we have again refined and improved our package options detailed on the next page.

While we are conscious of the financial commitments that present day living entails, we firmly believe there is a willingness within our parish to continue to provide the best sporting and recreation facilities for the people of Mooncoin (young and old).

We are very aware that we must build for the future of our club. We will continue to provide support and strengthen the links to both the Juvenile and Camogie clubs who do such great work in developing the skills of our young players (the future of our club). In recognition of this role, we are pleased to offer supporters of the Lucky Draw a 50% membership discount to each juvenile (underage) hurling and camogie player in their family towards this year's registration.
