A MESSAGE FROM OUR CLUB CHAIRPERSONS

Dear Parishioner,

We are writing to you from Mooncoin GAA and Camogie club representing our adult and juvenile members. We would like to take this opportunity to thank all parishioners for supporting our Lucky Draw fundraising initiative. The Lucky Draw was first introduced in 2019. Seven years later, the Lucky Draw has given away over €120,000 in prizes to over 1,200 members.

There is no escaping the fact that the Lucky Draw is now established as the primary source of funding for our three clubs which collective running costs total approximately €100,000 per year. Without your continued support the clubs could not continue to invest in players and facilities at the level that all players across all grades and codes have come to expect. It's essential to the future progression of our clubs that everyone who is supporting the draw continues to do so and that people who are in a position to become first time subscribers make it their business to join the draw either through the agent appointed to their area or by contacting any member of the executive.

In 2025, our teams had a number of successes on the field. Our Senior Footballers won the County League Final against Dicksboro in March and made it to the Championship Final against Mullinavat. Our Intermediate Hurling team also had strong performances throughout the League Championship. In August, our Junior D hurling team reached the Championship final against Erin's Own. In camogie, our Intermediate team defeated St. Lachtains to win the Intermediate Shield Final. They were also runners-up in the Intermediate County Championship. Our Junior C Camogie team were county finalists in August,

while our U16 and U14 teams were county finalists. Our U16 boys team won the Roinn B County Championship after a comeback victory against Carrickshock.

The success of our adult and juvenile club teams is based on serious work behind the scenes. Again in 2025, we invested heavily in strength & conditioning at both adult and juvenile levels. Our updated modern club gym is key to player development. We believe that continued investment in supporting our players will lead to further success for our club both on and off the field.

At juvenile level, the club appointed four young adult playing members as Games Promotion Officers (GPO) who provided regular structured coaching to all primary school children in the parish for six weeks in May and June. This club programme has assisted the primary schools again in 2025, when the U11/U13 Schools teams achieved a historic double, winning both Roinn A titles and winning the Football Country Cup. The initiative continues to be widely welcomed by school principals, teachers and parents. The club is already planning to continue the programme this year.

Our facilities and pitches are key to the success of our teams. Funds from the Lucky Draw have again enabled the club to maintain their high standard and condition. Early in 2025, severe damage was caused to our complex roof from storm Éowyn. A club survives on volunteerism, which was evident when so many members answered the call to help with the clean up operation. We wish to acknowledge everyone who was so willing to help. However, the remainder of the complex roof is in urgent need of replacing to restore our

facilities to the highest standard possible for everyone to use and enjoy for years to come.

The Lucky Draw entry itself remains at just €3.84 per week and we are delighted to outline some of the new draw prizes and benefits.

The increased total prize pot per month now stands at €1,950 for 2026, giving you a chance to win one of 20 cash prizes (increased from 15 in 2025) from February to November.
